Indonesian Presidential Museum

Located within the Presidential Palace complex in Bogor, West Java Province, the museum is a national institution established to commemorate the former presidents of Indonesia. Through photographs, artifacts, manuscripts, and multimedia displays, it showcases the lives and achievements of presidents such as Sukarno and Suharto. The museum aims to promote the spiritual heritage and historical contributions of the nation's leaders.



National Museum of Indonesia

Nicknamed the “Elephant Museum” for the bronze elephant statue at its entrance, this museum serves as a key window into Indonesia’s rich history and culture. It houses over 140,000 artifacts, including ancient stone tools, Hindu-Buddhist bronze statues, Javanese shadow puppetry props,

and traditional costumes from across the archipelago. The top-floor Treasure Room is a must-see, featuring royal gold jewelry and nationally treasured relics.

Government

The Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs of Indonesia



Directly under the President of Indonesia, this core economic policy coordination body was established in 1999. **Its primary function is to oversee, integrate, and coordinate national economic policies, facilitating cross-sector collaboration among 14 key economic ministries, including the Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Industry, and Ministry of Trade.** The ministry ensures the effective implementation of macroeconomic strategies and promotes sustainable economic growth and a favorable investment climate. Actively engaged in international forums such as the G20, it serves as a crucial hub for advancing Indonesia's economic development.

The Coordinating Ministry for Maritime Affairs and Investment of Indonesia



Established in 2019, this key policy coordination body operates directly under the President of Indonesia. Led by Minister Luhut Binsar Pandjaitan, **the ministry focuses on the integrated management of maritime resources, investment acceleration, and the development of regional economic corridors.** It coordinates the efforts of 12 relevant ministries and agencies, including the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries, the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources, and the Ministry of Investment.

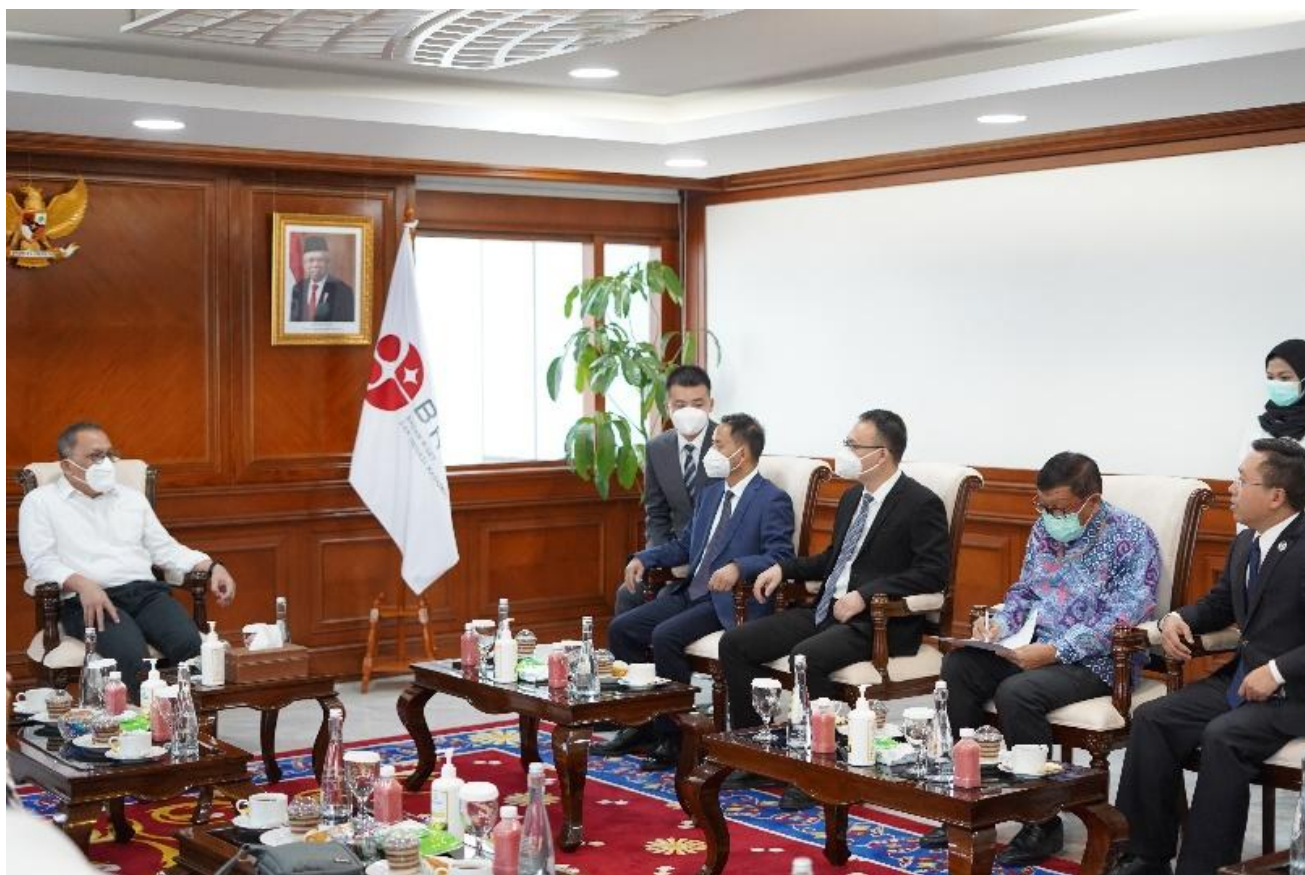
A central driver of Indonesia's "Global Maritime Fulcrum" strategy, the ministry plays a vital role in facilitating major foreign investment projects. In recent years, it has led the coordination of strategic national investments, including Belt and Road Initiative cooperation and the country's transition to green energy.

The Ministry of Trade of Indonesia



As the central authority responsible for formulating and regulating national trade policy, the Ministry of Trade reports directly to the President. **Its core functions include import and export control, trade licensing, anti-dumping investigations, and maintaining domestic market stability.** The ministry also leads Indonesia's participation in multilateral trade negotiations such as the ASEAN Free Trade Area (AFTA) and the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP), ensuring national trade competitiveness and supply chain security. The Ministry plays a vital role in shaping Indonesia's strategy on free trade agreements, digital trade, and trade balance, making it a key pillar of the country's broader economic policy framework.

The National Research and Innovation Agency of Indonesia



Established on April 28, 2021, BRIN is a national-level research institution directly under the Indonesian government. It was formed through the integration of several former research bodies, including the Indonesian Institute of Sciences (LIPI), the National Institute of Aeronautics and Space (LAPAN), and the National Nuclear Energy Agency (BATAN).

BRIN is tasked with the centralized coordination of the country's research and innovation activities. **Its core responsibilities include formulating national science and technology policies, promoting the commercialization of research outcomes, fostering international cooperation, and supporting Indonesia's strategic goal of becoming an innovation-driven nation by 2045.**

Business

Sarinah



Established in 1962 under the direct initiative of Indonesia's first President, Sukarno, this retail group is the country's oldest and the only state-controlled enterprise in the sector. Operating under the Ministry of State-Owned Enterprises (BUMN), it plays a strategic dual role: stabilizing consumer goods prices and promoting national culture.

With a core mission of “**Proudly Made in Indonesia,**” the group operates through self-owned department stores, e-commerce platforms, and integrated cultural-tourism complexes. It focuses on incubating local MSME (UMKM) brands, serving as a key vehicle for empowering domestic industry and advancing Indonesia's cultural and economic presence both domestically and internationally.

Yantaitai Bird's Nest Group



Originating from Indonesia and backed by four generations of expertise, Yantaitai's is a well-established bird's nest brand. Its parent company, Yantaitai Group, is a fully integrated supplier in Indonesia's bird's nest industry, covering the entire value chain—from harvesting and primary processing to deep processing, international trade, and product innovation.

In 2009, the brand entered the Chinese market and established Shanghai Yanzitang Food Co., Ltd., offering a diverse product portfolio including ready-to-eat bird's nest, dried nest pieces, freshly stewed bird's nest, and bird's nest rice dumplings. **Upholding the philosophy of "Purely Indonesian, Truly Premium," the brand is committed to delivering high-quality bird's nest products and professional services to customers worldwide.**

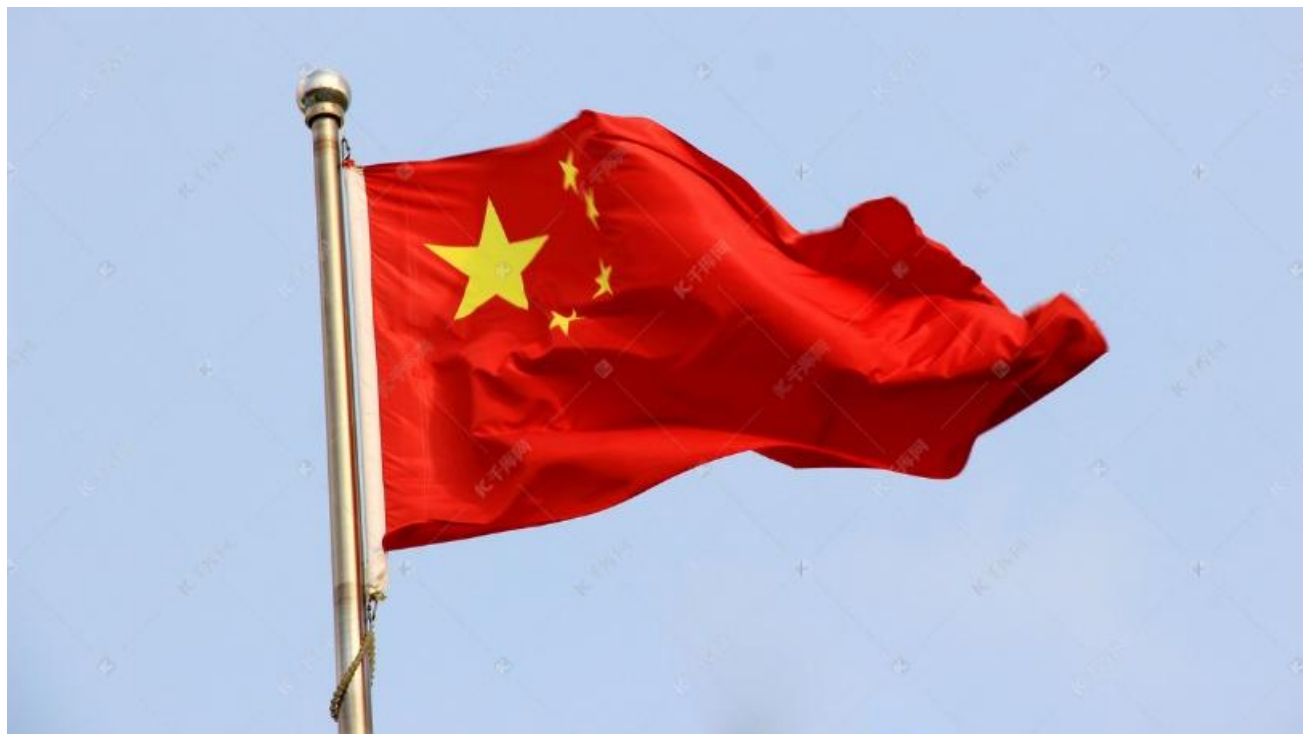
Kawasan Industri Cikarang, Jababeka



Developed by the publicly listed company PT Jababeka Tbk in 1989, Jababeka Industrial Estate covers 5,600 hectares and hosts over 2,500 multinational corporations, including Panasonic, Samsung, and IKEA. The estate integrates **manufacturing clusters, bonded logistics, a commercial CBD, education and healthcare facilities**, as well as eco-friendly residential areas. Known as the "Industrial Engine of Indonesia," it boasts core advantages such as one-stop infrastructure services, proximity to Jakarta (a 40-minute drive), and designation as a National Strategic Project (PSN) with direct presidential support.

Chinese Institutions in Indonesia

Embassy of the People's Republic of China in the Republic of Indonesia



The official diplomatic mission of the People's Republic of China in Indonesia, located at Mega Kuningan No. 2, South Jakarta. The embassy comprises multiple departments, including Political, Economic and Commercial, Cultural, and Consular sections. **It is responsible for promoting bilateral relations between China and Indonesia, providing services to Chinese citizens residing in Indonesia, and facilitating economic, trade, and cultural exchanges.**

In addition to the embassy in Jakarta, China also maintains Consulates General in Surabaya, Medan, and Denpasar to assist with consular services and regional affairs.

Jakarta-Bandung High-Speed Railway



The Jakarta-Bandung High-Speed Railway is Indonesia's first high-speed rail line and the first of its kind in Southeast Asia. Spanning 142.3 kilometers with a design speed of 350 km/h, it connects the capital city Jakarta with Bandung in West Java Province, reducing travel time from approximately three hours to around 40 minutes.

The project is constructed and operated by PT Kereta Cepat Indonesia China (KCIC), a China-Indonesia joint venture, and utilizes Chinese standards and technology.

This railway marks the first overseas full-system, full-element, and full-industry-chain implementation of China's high-speed rail.

Officially launched on October 2, 2023, the Jakarta-Bandung high-speed rail has significantly improved Indonesia's transportation infrastructure and boosted economic development along the route.

China–Indonesia “Twin Parks” Initiative



The China–Indonesia “Twin Parks” is a new platform for industrial cooperation launched under the joint initiative of the two governments, aiming to **achieve “park connectivity, industrial complementarity, and mutually beneficial cooperation.”**

The Chinese park is located in Yuanhong Investment Zone, Fuzhou, Fujian Province, focusing on industries such as food processing and the marine economy. The Indonesian counterpart is situated on Tarakan Island, North Kalimantan, with key development areas in resource processing, green energy, and industrial manufacturing.

Officially launched in 2021, this project serves as a flagship demonstration of aligning the Belt and Road Initiative with Indonesia’s “Global Maritime Fulcrum” strategy.

China National Machinery Industry Corporation



As a key member of China National Machinery Industry Corporation, this office focuses on international engineering contracting, investment, and trade. The Indonesia branch is primarily responsible for project development and management within the country.

Its core areas include energy and power (thermal power and biomass power plants), industrial manufacturing (sugar mills, cement plants, nickel smelting), and public infrastructure. Operating mainly under the EPC (Engineering, Procurement, and Construction) turnkey model, notable projects include the Takalar Sugar Mill—one of Southeast Asia’s largest—and the Sulawesi ferronickel industrial park. The office exemplifies the integration of Chinese standards with local practices, serving as a benchmark enterprise in advancing China’s overseas footprint.

Natural and Cultural Heritage

Merdeka Square



Located in the heart of Jakarta, Indonesia, the square covers approximately one square kilometer and is one of the largest city squares in the world. At its center stands the 132-meter-tall National Monument (Monas), symbolizing the spirit of the Indonesian people's struggle for independence.

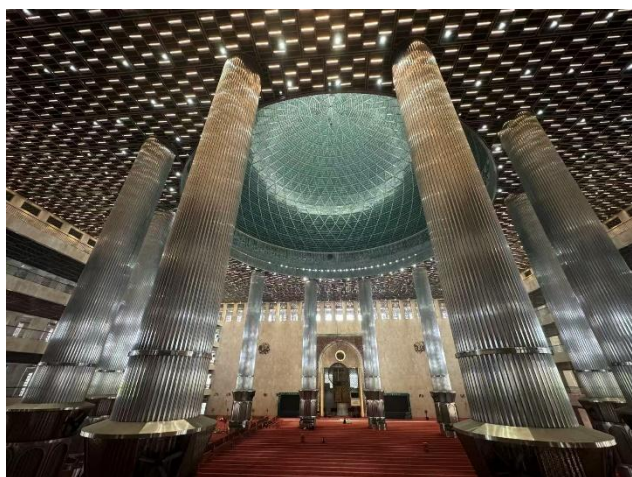
The monument's golden flame at the top is made of 14.5 tons of bronze covered with gold leaf, representing the eternal flame of independence. Inside the monument are a history museum and an observation deck, offering visitors panoramic views of Jakarta.

National Museum of Indonesia



Nicknamed the “Elephant Museum” for the bronze elephant statue at its entrance, this museum serves as a key window into Indonesia's rich history and culture. It houses over 140,000 artifacts, including ancient stone tools, Hindu-Buddhist bronze statues, Javanese shadow puppetry props, and traditional costumes from across the archipelago. Istiqlal Mosque



The largest mosque in Indonesia and the biggest Islamic religious building in Southeast Asia, located in the heart of Jakarta near the National Monument. Completed in 1978, the mosque's name, "Istiqlal," means "independence," symbolizing Indonesia's liberation from colonial rule and the achievement of national independence.

The architecture blends modern design with Islamic elements and can accommodate over 120,000 worshippers. It stands as a significant religious and cultural symbol for Indonesian Muslims and is also open to the public, welcoming visitors from around the world.

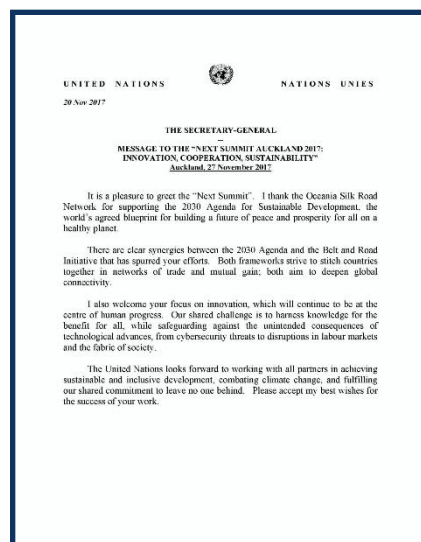

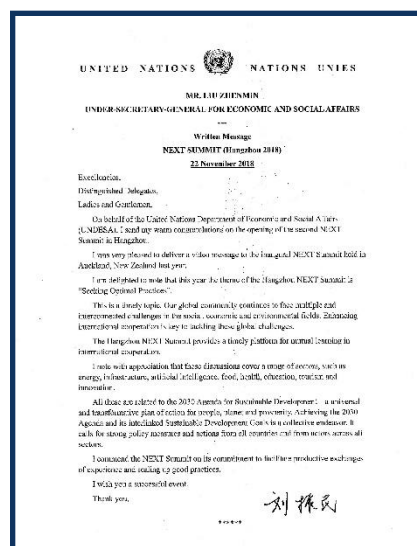
